

LCIF REPORT - US

From Kristi Garcia LCIF Staff coordinator:

1. We discovered that the report card was using fundraising data from the Canadian side of split districts in MD19. I have updated it manually to include the CA1 fundraising information for those districts. IT is currently working on a permanent fix. Until then, I'll continue updating the monthly report cards for MDs with split districts by hand.
2. The process for selecting a Club LCIF Coordinator is guided by LCIF and LCI leadership policies. Ideally, clubs should appoint a volunteer to serve in this role. However, if no one volunteers or is appointed, it is expected that the Immediate Past Club President (IPCP/IPP) will automatically take on the responsibilities of the Club LCIF Coordinator. This approach ensures the position is always filled, supporting continuity in leadership and fundraising efforts.

This procedure is outlined in the LCIF nomination policy, which provides official guidance for clubs.

Explanation to share with new officers:

When discussing this with incoming club officers, you can explain it as follows:

1. The Club LCIF Coordinator is a recommended position and may not always be a separately elected officer.
2. If no member volunteers or is appointed to serve as the Club LCIF Coordinator, the Immediate Past President automatically assumes the role to ensure the club remains engaged and connected with LCIF initiatives.
