INDUCTION CEREMONY AWARD RULES

A TEAM made up of two or more members from one Lions or one Leo Club who have created a ceremony or have customized one of the Induction ceremonies provided by Lions Clubs International to reflect their club. The ceremony is designed to welcome a new member or members into the club in a meaningful way.

ELIGIBILITY: They must be the winner, or in the case where the winner is unable to compete in the Multiple District 19 contest, the runner-up of the competition held at the District Spring Convention.

The District Governor or District Contests and Awards Chairperson sends the names of the winner and runner-up to the MD19 Office and MD19 Contests and Awards Chairperson within 30 days of the District Convention.

CEREMONY: The Induction Team will place emphasis on “induction” rather than “indoctrination”. An induction is a ceremonial event where someone is officially welcomed into an organization or group and is officially recognized as a member of that group or organization.

TIME LIMIT: The time for presentation will be limited to 10 minutes. A penalty of 1 point per minute, or fraction thereof, shall be assessed against the team running over the 10-minute limit.

JUDGING WILL BE BASED ON:

10 points for APPEARANCE

20 points for CONTENT

20 points for PRESENTATION
